The Blosser Center requires that trainees enroll in both the Coursework and Practicum Part I in the same school year. After successful completion of the Coursework and Practicum Part 1, the student will be invited to enroll for the Practicum Part II. In each Practicum, the trainee tutors two children.

The complete course requires all three segments which takes one academic year plus four weeks in summer school OR two academic years.
